

The new C48 is a complete turn-key craft that offers the flexibility to cruise in all weathers. No need to prepare canopies or covers before you set off, simply walk on and take off.

It's a sense of freedom that is built into every aspect of the craft. From the uninterrupted views of the cockpit with its panoramic wraparound windscreen, to an enclosed saloon and helm that means you're ready to go wherever, whenever.

Even the interior space of the C48 is brimming with possibilities. Simply slide back the patio door between the cockpit and the saloon to create a best in class social space. Activate the electrically powered sunroof to bring the outside in. Dine six in comfort within the saloon. Go alfresco in the cockpit. Or simply laze the day away on a 2m wide teak-laid bathing platform. The choice is yours.

For additional comfort below deck, there's a spacious open plan galley with an optional split-level wine chiller, integrated hob and oven and enough space to accommodate a washing machine, dishwasher and large refrigeration unit.

For a longer cruising experience, you can look forward to superb sleeping accommodation. Along with double berth forward VIP cabin, you'll find a mid cabin with two bunks. A large midship master cabin offers exceptional room with full standing height, panoramic hull windows, and full-height wardrobes tall enough to hold dresses or gowns.

Perfect for outdoor living, the SC42 opens up to allow the sun and breeze to stream in. And when it's time to take a cool break in the shade, a unique full length, electric soft-top convertible roof system can be deployed in seconds.


The cockpit takes advantage of the full beam width to provide ample space for seating and entertaining, while at the helm you'll find four wide forward-facing seats, a fully integrated dashboard, a wet bar and a foldaway TV behind the seats. To really appreciate how much space has been created within the SC42, you simply need to take a tour of the living quarters. A beautifully styled saloon offers the freedom to dine in comfort and easily converts into a double berth, while the galley has enough room to accommodate a full height fridge freezer and over 2.5m of worktop workspace.

Even when it comes to retire, everyone is guaranteed a comfortable repose. A luxurious forward master cabin offers double wardrobes plus a large separate shower compartment. Family or friends can relax in a flexible three-berth cabin that offers five different sleeping combinations, while the en suite shower and toilet ensure that everything is close to hand.

Step onto the stylish cockpit and the SC35's extraordinary amount of space is evident. With enough seating for you to entertain eight guests and an outdoor mini galley, this is an open and inviting world you'll want to share with your family and friends.

The cockpit table folds over and lowers to create a generous sun bed allowing you to transform the cockpit from entertaining to lounging with ease. And with an innovative translucent convertible roof, you can switch the all weather cockpit from an open space to completely enclosed. In seconds. When you want to enjoy the open sea, a twin helm seat with bolster and great visibility through the screens make your journey all the more comfortable. And fun. Below deck, the fresh and modern interior has an exceptional head height of 6ft 4 inches which, coupled with the large saloon skylight, creates a light, spacious feel. While the large, fully equipped L shaped galley has excellent storage allowing you to cater for everyone. Double doors from the saloon open to the forward cabin, giving you an open plan feel throughout the boat; again the large hatch skylight bathes the area in natural light. The en-suite and day head has a separate full head-height shower and separate head offering practicality and comfort, while the aft cabin holds three permanent berths – a first for this class of boat – with another large hatch skylight.

And with our distinctive deep V hull, created in collaboration with world championship powerboat designer Ocke Mannerfelt and the Sealine design team, you'll experience an efficient, stable and comfortable ride at any speed. Giving you more scope to enjoy your time on board, however you choose.



The generous beam width creates the largest internal volume of a boat of this size; an exceptional space that includes five permanent berths and a large L shaped galley with double doors into the forward cabin giving you a relaxing open plan feel. The atmosphere of the lower deck is characterised by the abundance of natural light pouring in through skylights in each area. The saloon's airy feel is accentuated by the large saloon skylight with integrated blind, which combined with horizontal portholes, means you can benefit from excellent natural ventilation throughout the lower deck.

And as part of your total experience, the new deep V hull form, designed in collaboration with world championship powerboat designer Ocke Mannerfelt, is shaped to give you cruising that's comfortable yet efficient.


















Designing boats like everyone else is easy. Making waves takes a far more individual approach.

As an agile company that is less restricted, less prescriptive and more focused on innovation, we have been able to explore and ask 'why not?' for over 40 years.

Every aspect of our design has a reason so that nothing is superfluous. We blend the very best of modern British industrial design with our unique use of space and light. Crisp, linear lines, freshness and unrivalled connectivity creating stylish, comfortable sanctuaries that live in the real world.

The confidence we hold in our approach to designing and building boats like no other is clear to see. From the SC35 turning heads to the F46 and F42 revolutionising flybridge design to the C48 taking our innovative use of space to new heights.


But this design ambition cannot be achieved working in isolation. Inspiration comes from all around, whether it is a classic car that broke the rules, or the forms of nature shaped by time. Just as importantly, we talk to customers. And listen. Our Design Director, Carsten Astheimer, has embarked on tours to talk with Sealine customers at length, while his team visits marinas to gain even greater insight into the views of a wider audience of boat owners on styling, usage, what you like, and equally, what you don't. Understanding that is further strengthened by the fact that many of us here are keen boaters.

Above all, the creation of a Sealine is about true partnership and collaboration. Each boat design begins to take shape on the computer of Richard Crocker, our Senior Naval Architect with over 20 years experience. From here, the combined talents of Sealine's team of engineering and product development experts will evolve the design to fulfil both form and function under Richard's careful direction. It's a holistic process, undertaken to predetermined design and quality standards to produce a cruising boat that goes beyond convention whilst instilling confidence. A perfect example of design vision and engineering prowess coming together can be seen on board the F46, F42 and new C48 in the daring geometry of the stunning wraparound windscreen. By adopting an unprecedented approach to boat design, adopting revolutionary techniques and even calling on the expertise of aerospace experts, the impossible became possible. A windscreen with the largest possible facade, giving unrivalled panoramic visibility from the lower helm.

Pushing boundaries has always been the driving force for the Sealine design. And the journey has only just begun.

Boats built on confidence.

Becoming a Sealine boat is a far from easy process with every conceivable aspect analysed, scrutinised and tested – in the virtual world, and the real one.

Before the boat is even built, our advanced finite element analysis technology enables us to carry out a full structural analysis of the hull itself, as well as all supporting structures and component parts; from fuel tanks to backrests and guardrails. While computational fluid dynamic modelling determines exactly how the boat will handle, how spray will deflect from the hull and how the breeze will flow over the decks whilst underway to ensure a blend of efficiency and exhilaration.

In the Sealine Product Validation Laboratory, years vanish in days as we undertake lifespan endurance analysis and quality assessments. Metal components are assessed as 10 years of use is compressed into just 21 days under the corrosive salty mist of the humidity chamber. Gel coat samples endure a year's worth of equatorial sunlight in just 10 weeks to determine resistance to the effects of solar exposure. Test engineers have exerted hundreds of kilograms of pressure on stainless steel handrails and backrests to ensure their tensile strength. We even drop a 28-gram ball bearing from 2 metres onto sample pieces of teak flooring, so we know that if you drop your cutlery, there's no need to worry.


Our finished boats face, and overcome, countless challenges including 960 sub-assembly production line checks, 600 hull assembly line item checks, 308 engine and electrical system checks, two days of pool testing, a full final boat audit of 215 tests and on to 500 hours of sea trials. But even before it leaves the factory, your boat will have been continuously drenched for 12 hours in a special atomisation test that lasts six times longer than the industry norm.

Once these punishing tests are complete, our boats have to come through equally daunting challenges out at sea. At our Sea Trial Centre all new models are rigorously tested. Frequently, a Sealine boat will be put through a whole year's worth of typical usage in just three months. These demanding trials are conducted by our own master yachtsman, a seasoned veteran who, with over 10,000 hours at sea aboard Sealine boats, helps to validate design and build.

We even go to the extreme of taking our boats out in storms of up to gale force 8 with significant wave heights up to 4 metres. We do this for a minimum of eight hours so that you know our boats are solid enough to get you back should you be caught offshore.

In short, we test every component of every model to limits that you will simply never reach. Integrity isn't simply placed at the centre of our business. It's built into the very heart of our boats.





We put two things into your boat: heart and soul.

Blending painstaking precision and 40 years of craftsmanship, from the smallest stitching detail on the saloon scatter cushions to curving handrails to the galley worktop, Sealine produces many of its furniture and fittings as part of its manufacturing process. This may be a longstanding tradition for the company, but that hasn't stopped it incorporating modern materials and techniques to set new standards in quality. We were the first small boat builder, for instance, to introduce a complete matt wood finish with our use of American walnut.

Sealine designs possess an unmistakably distinctive nature; ultimately simple and in every sense functional, yet at the same time, enticingly stylish. Nevertheless, our aesthetic decisions are always underpinned by our demand for quality and practicality. Our materials can only be selected once they have passed a number of industry standard and in-house tests. We insist on only using antimicrobial and antifungal fabrics, and choose only fire-resistant upholstery. We stain test and abrade every thread and fabric 10,000 times; that's equivalent to 10 years' use onboard. The material for our sunshades is monitored for its screening ability using thermal imaging cameras. And no fewer than 12 scrupulous steps are taken to source one piece of wood and transform it into a finished piece, with every stage quality assessed.

Nothing is incidental. Flooring, for instance, is grain matched across an entire expanse of floor. Any joints are carefully mapped

out so that every last millimetre creates a perfect whole. When you walk across the floor of a Sealine, it quite simply has to be flawless.

Our dedicated craftsmen and women work together as one team to create an exceptional experience. This is what a Sealine is all about.
